As of now, one month before Tábor's Queer Pride Parade, 272 Czechs have registered to participate in the Parade. Registering for the Parade not only helps the organizers prepare for the event, but also allows important information to be shared with the event participants. Those who don't manage to register for the Parade via internet can still register before the Parade the morning of June 20 at the Parade Starting Point.

Due to continuing construction in and around the Tábor train station, the Parade Starting Point has been moved to the traditional Tábor gathering point on Masaryk square. "Because of this change the Parade Route will be shorter," says organizer Hilary Binder, "but being in the heart of the city will bring more attention to the event."

From 10 AM on Saturday, June 20, you will find the registration table, Queer Pride information tables, refreshments and a stage for announcements and presentations supporting the non-heterosexual community and welcoming the participants of the Pride Parade.

The first of three workshops for Queer Pride Tábor volunteers took place last week as part of the Warm Spring/Teplé jaro Queer Parade Brno events. The next workshop is scheduled for Sunday, May 24 as part of eLnadruhou's 15th NOT ONLY lesbian culture festival in Prague. In June the final volunteer workshop will be in Tábor.

The City of Tábor's cultural fund granted the Queer Pride Tábor event 10,000Kč towards realizing the cultural program for the Queer Pride Festival. Additionally, a number of local Tábor businesses have offered financial support, or discounts primarily on services such as food and accommodation.
